

# Minority Ethnic Future Leaders Network

## About the network

United Learning is committed to creating an inclusive culture and building a more diverse workforce, particularly at leadership level. To support this, in June we will launch a series of networks for teaching staff from groups under-represented in leadership- our first network will be for Minority Ethnic teachers.

Led by Khaleekh Khalique, Vice Principal at William Hulme's Grammar School, the Minority Ethnic Future Leaders Network aims to increase leadership skills and confidence as well as encourage progression on to leadership pathways.

As a participant you will be given the opportunity to hear from a range of leaders from across the United Learning, network with colleagues from across the Group and will be supported to plan your own leadership journey.

The network will launch on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2022, at 16:00-17:30pm with a webinar delivered by Jon Coles (CEO) and Khaleekh Khalique (VP at WHGS and network leader).

## Content and Delivery

The network will run online, with webinar or seminar delivered every 1-2 weeks via Microsoft Teams. The network will run a total of seven sessions.

These will include:

- Developing key leadership skills and knowledge through facilitated workshops.
- Hearing from United Learning leaders who represent the network about their experiences.
- An exploration of leadership theory.
- Support in planning your own leadership journey.
- Support with leadership interviews.
- An opportunity to connect with colleagues and share best practice.
