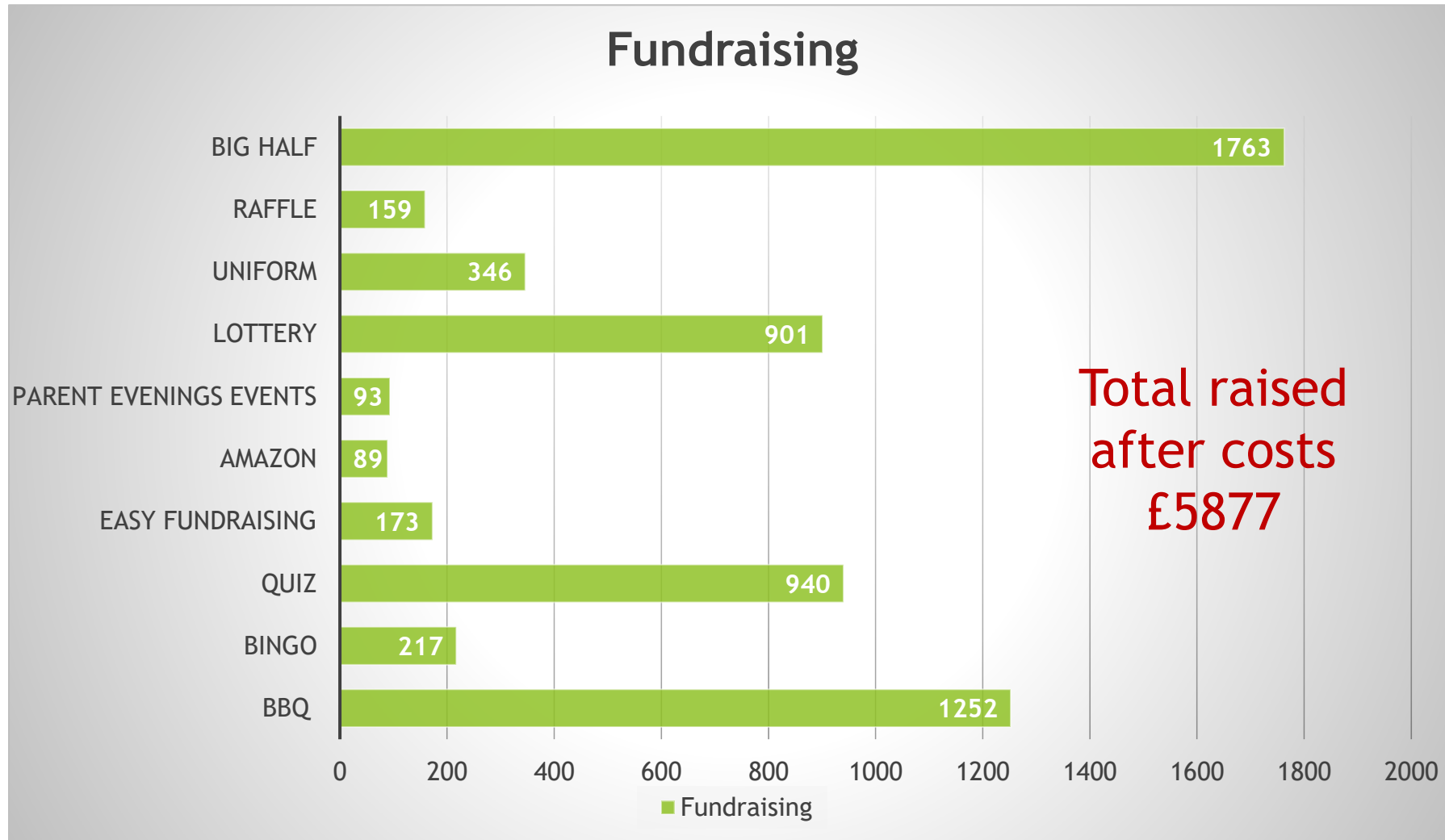


We supported our school during their events

- ▶ Parents evenings and induction days - teas and coffees and a friendly smile at 6 parent evenings and 2 induction days
- ▶ A bar, raffle and snacks at achievement evenings and school concerts raised £92 in donations
- ▶ Passport trail with teas and coffees at 3 Open evenings to support new students in year 6 and 6th form (chocolate brownies as a prize)
- ▶ Culture day - where families were welcomed to school in traditional costumes and bring a dish, celebrating EID
- ▶ Lost property hand out days - across the year the JRSA sought and hand out as much lost property as they can to students, you will be surprised at how much collects each day.
- ▶ Second hand uniform day, the last Tuesday of every term the JRSA sells nearly new uniform at very low costs which raised £346 in donations

 - ▶ 19th June

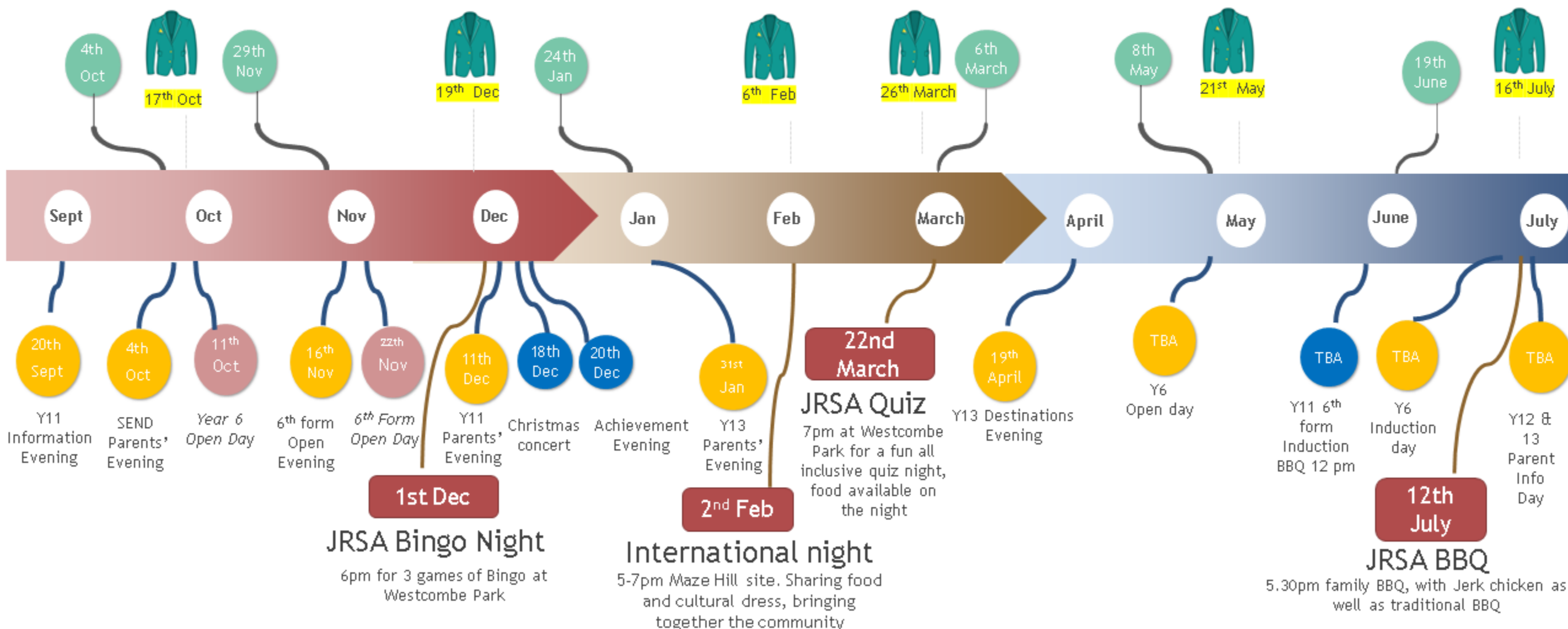

We have a very busy schedule throughout the year and always need more help from parents and the school community



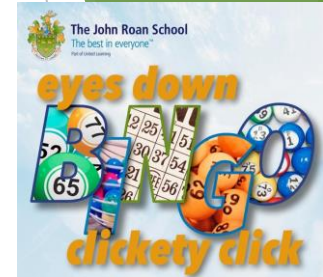

- ▶ Uniform sales - Two sales took place the last Tuesday of each term - Profits £205 (up on last year)
- ▶ Christmas tree sales £25 - should we do this next year??
- ▶ Hardship Crowdfunding - **NEW** - Lucie Murphy set up crowdfunding page through Just Giving with the target of £3000 to give 30 families £100 Aldi gift card for Christmas. Through social media we reached out to the John Roan community and overachieved, bringing in £3120 via JustGiving.
- ▶ Go Fund me Christmas run - Raised £1398 from 73 donations for the Don McMath Foundation and Disasters Emergency Committee
- ▶ Parent Pay portal - received donations of £246 through John Roan Families, this will all be added to the bidding pot of next year.
