

### The John Roan School Student Uniform Expectations 2022-2023

The John Roan School demonstrates **PRIDE** in our uniform which has been a long-standing tradition of the school. Wearing smart uniform helps to:

Students are expected to wear full school uniform on the way to and from school.

Students who arrive at school without the correct uniform may either be asked to return home (with parental consent) to correct their uniform, or they will undertake work in the DFL (Disruption Free Learning Room) until the uniform issue is rectified. Where possible, students will be provided with correct uniform to enable them to attend lessons.

If you are in any doubt about details within this guidance, please contact the school directly to prevent any unnecessary expense. Please do not rely on reassurances from students or shops, because these can be incorrect.

| School Blazer     | Green with The John Roan School logo              | To be kept smart and clean<br>To be worn at all times during the day, as well as to and from the school, unless directed otherwise by staff.<br>Only original buttons to be used to fasten – no safety pins etc.<br>Sleeves to be worn at full length, not rolled-up.<br>Only school-issued badges to adorn the blazer. | <a href="http://www.jkclothing.net/">http://www.jkclothing.net/</a><br><a href="https://khalsaschoolwear.co.uk/school/john-roan-school/">https://khalsaschoolwear.co.uk/school/john-roan-school/</a> |
| Trousers          | Black, formal, tailored style, full length        | No jean-like, corduroy, high-fashion, overly tight trousers, leggings, jeggings, skinny trousers, short ankle or shorts.<br>Trousers should be worn with a secure fit around the waist.<br>Belts should be black, plain and functional, with no oversized buckles or trimmings.   | Any retailer   |

| Shirt             | Plain white, traditional school shirt             | The shirt should be tucked in, buttoned at the neck and, if longed sleeved, sleeves must be worn at full length.<br>No other clothing to be visible under the shirt.<br>No designer shirts.<br>A shirt must be worn accompanied by the School tie.  | Any retailer   |

| Socks             | Black   | Must be plain, no pattern designs and worn below the knee. No pop socks. Not to be worn with tights.  | Any retailer   |
| Tights            | Black   | No footless, patterned or fishnet tights, leggings or legwarmers. Not to be worn with socks.  | Any retailer   |



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| Shoes                   | Polished black, traditional style, black stitching, black sole and heel | A plain design, no trimmings, logos, decorative buckles, coloured laces or stitching, labels, or other decorations. No shoe/trainer hybrid footwear, trainers, fabric shoes, or boots of any kind.  | Any retailer   |
| Coat/Jacket (Optional)  | Plain outdoor jacket or coat. Preferably plain black or navy.           | Plain Coat/Jacket no large logo or pattern. Whenever possible it should be plain black or navy blue. No hoodies or combination of fabric/knitted tops, cardigans, jumpers, sweatshirts, tracksuit tops, waistcoats, sleeveless tops, body warmers, denim jackets etc. | Any retailer   |
| Scarf (Optional)        | Plain black or Navy blue  | Plain black or dark blue, no logo. No pashminas. If worn for religious reasons, head scarf should be plain black and correctly worn. Only scarfs worn for religious reasons are permitted inside the school building.   | Any retailer   |
| Bag                     | A plain rucksack, large enough to carry schoolbooks and equipment.      | Bags must be suitable for carrying school books and PE kit. Plastic carrier bags, handbags, purse bags, shoulder pouches and other inappropriate fashion bags will not be permitted.  | Any retailer   |

| PE Shorts               | Black   | Plain black Shorts – These should be thigh length lycra shorts or football style. No stripes or coloured panels. No hot pants/small shorts.   | Any retailer   |
| PE Socks                | White   | White Sports Socks.   | Any retailer   |
| Tracksuit bottoms       | Black   | Black tracksuit bottoms - No stripes or coloured panels.  | Any retailer   |
| PE Trainers             | Any   | Sports trainers. Trainers must have non-marking soles. Plimsolls, canvas and high tops shoes must not be worn.  | Any retailer   |

| Football boots | Football boots | Football boots with studs are the only acceptable footwear on the all-weather pitch (Trainers and blades are NOT permitted). | Any retailer |

**FURTHER INFORMATION**

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| Hair/Appearance     | <p>Individual fashion statements such as extreme hairstyles or non- natural colours are not permitted. This includes non-natural hair colour included into braids.<br/>Only black or dark blue hair accessories are allowed.<br/>No decorative attachments, coloured weaves or extensions are to be worn in the hair.<br/>Shaved lines in the hair or eyebrows are not permitted.<br/>Extreme shaved sides are not permitted. No scalp should be visible.<br/>No excessive makeup, e.g. lip gloss, lip stick, eyeliner and eye shadow, nail varnish, nail decorations, French tips or extensions are not permitted.<br/>Tinted or cosmetic contact lenses and decorative dental wear are not permitted.<br/>No false eyelashes.<br/>No hoods, hats, caps, durag or bandannas to be worn anywhere on the school grounds.<br/>Fashion spectacles are not permitted.</p> |
| Jewellery/Valuables | <p>No jewellery except for one wrist watch and a maximum of one pair of small plain, gold or silver ball (no stones) stud earrings.<br/>One small, plain gold/silver nose stud.<br/>No chains or bracelets may be worn or brought to school. The only expectations are items of religious significance – crosses, Stars of David, etc (which should be on a long chain and tucked in so that nothing is visible).<br/>Facial and body piercings or visible tattoos are not permitted.<br/>Prohibited earrings or nose studs cannot be covered with a plaster.</p>   |



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|         | <p>Piercings should be done over the 6 weeks holiday to avoid uniform infringement issues as often stone earrings are used for piercings.</p> <p>No accessories are to be worn around the neck, wrists, and ankles or attached to clothing.</p> <p>Money should be kept in a purse or wallet securely on their person. Large amounts of money and expensive personal effects should not be brought on site.</p> <p>The school will not accept liability for any claim arising from theft, accidental loss or damage to personal effects, money, belongings or clothing whilst on the premises.</p> <p>Computer tablets/games etc. must not be brought on site.</p> <p>We operate a 'not seen, not heard' policy towards mobile phones.</p> <p>Confiscated items are to be collected at the end of the school day. Where there are repeated offences, collection periods will be extended at the discretion of the school.</p> |
| Jumpers | No pullovers, sweatshirts, hoodies or waistcoats permitted other than the school items described above.   |
